

Scrum.org Professional Scrum Developer Course

What to expect

Professional Scrum Developer™ (PSD) is an immersive three-day course where students act as an entire Scrum team that concurrently works on requirements engineering, design, development, testing, integration and deployment within a single iteration. Agile engineering practices and supportive Application Lifecycle Management (ALM) tools are explored as ways to improve a team's capabilities.

Students work in self-organizing teams, collaborating during series of Sprints to turn requirements into high-quality, potentially shippable software. They'll apply modern engineering practices and use the Scrum framework to cope with changes, develop from a realistic Product Backlog and gain a real-world view of what it's like to build software in Increments with Scrum.

Who should attend

The PSD course is intended for all members of a Scrum Development Team: architects, programmers, database developers, testers and others with some technical knowledge.

Prerequisites

Attendees will benefit the most from this course if they:

- Have studied the Scrum Guide (required)
- Have taken the Scrum Open and Scrum Developer Open (free online assessment)
- Have taken the Professional Scrum Foundations course
- Have experience or exposure to a Scrum Team
- Have been on or closely involved with a project that builds or enhances a product
